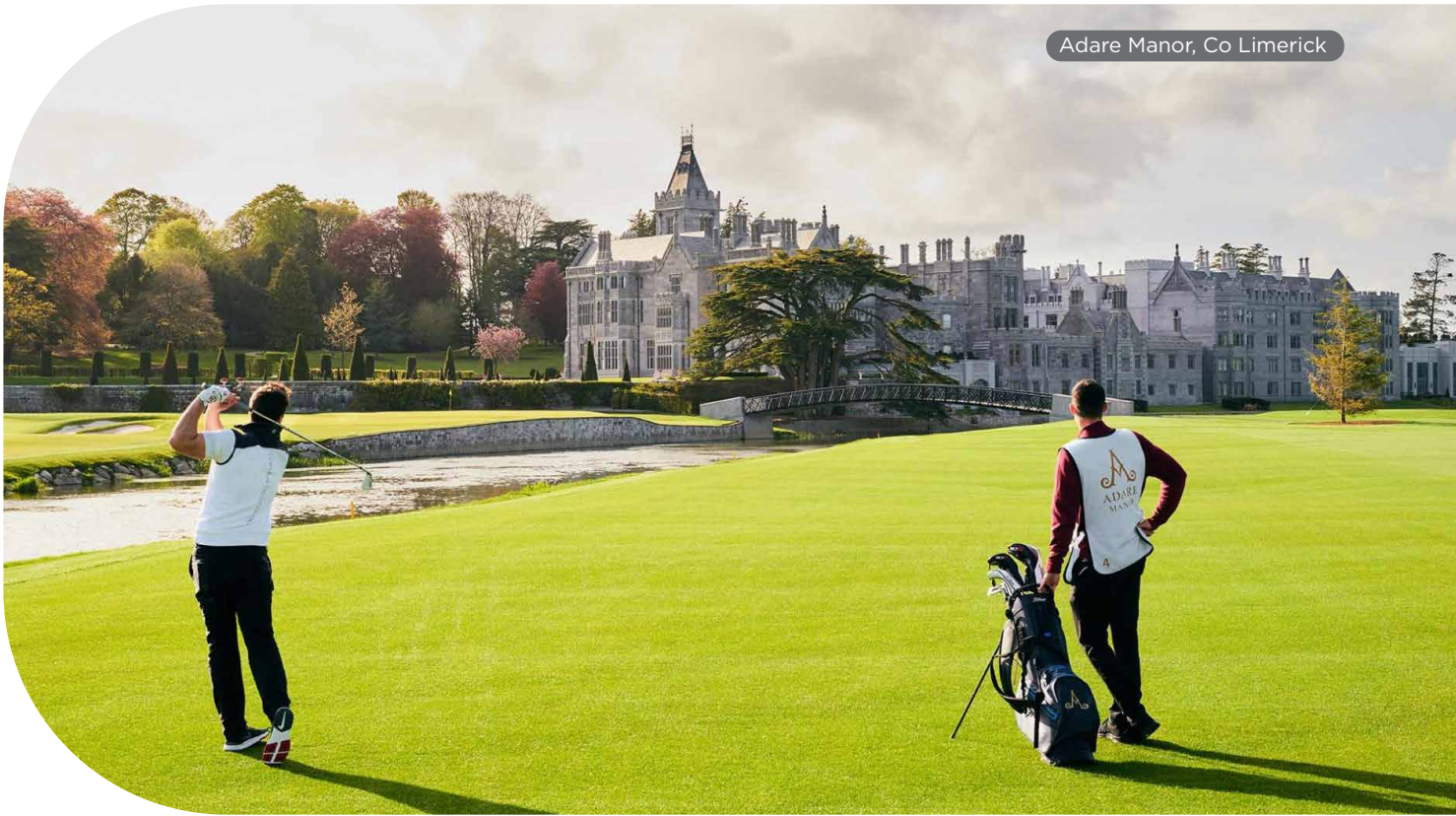

The Guide is broken down into 5 main sections, based on the five main regions in Ireland;

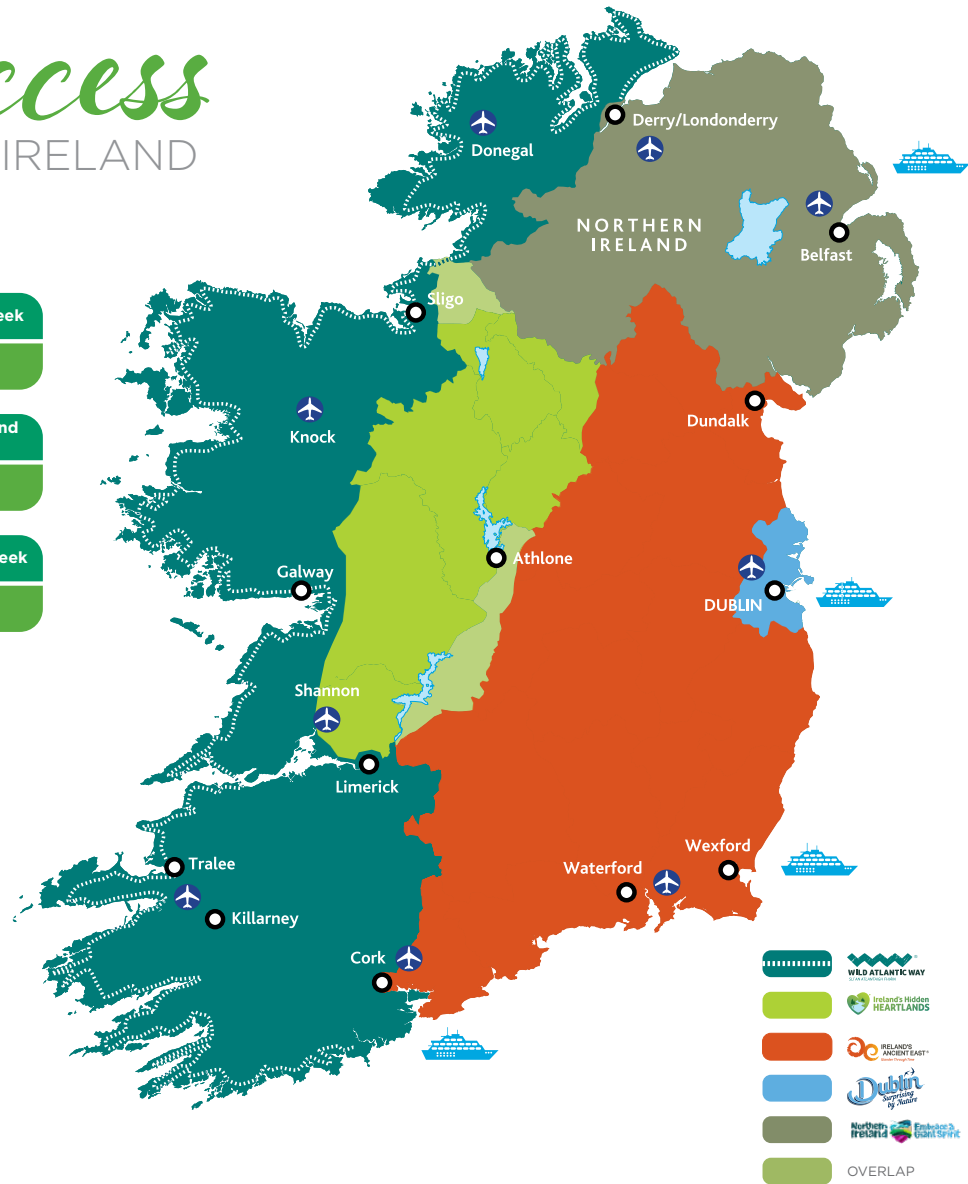

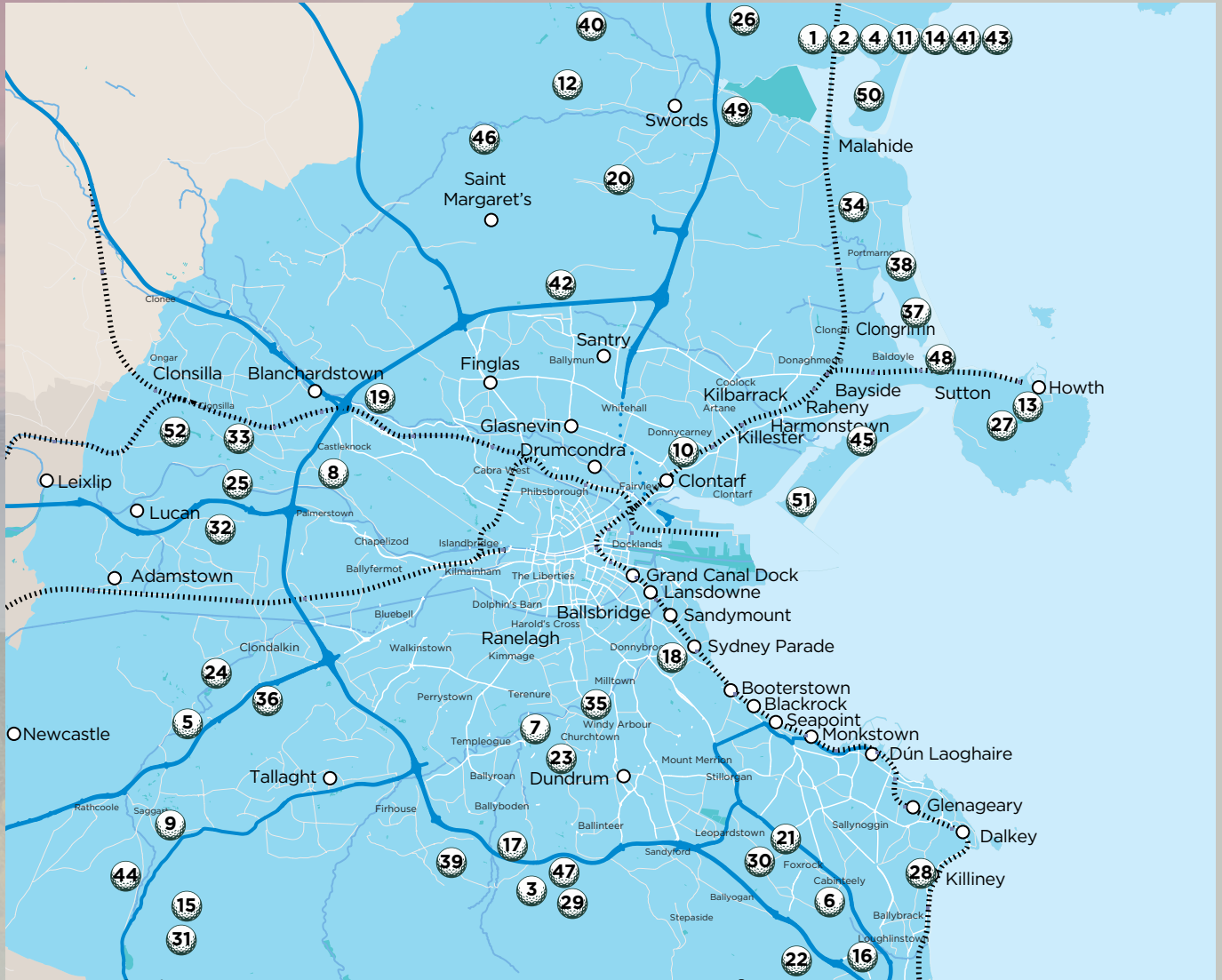

Their contents are priceless, but entry to Ireland's national museums and galleries is free! You can skip from 'Bog Bodies' at The National Museum of Archaeology to canvases by Caravaggio and Jack B Yeats at the National Gallery.



DRINK A DROP OF DUBLIN

You can't visit Dublin without sampling Guinness. The Guinness Storehouse, located beside the famous brewery at St James' Gate, wraps several floors of exhibitions and advertising displays around a pint shaped atrium. Or enjoy a drop of whiskey at one of our famous distilleries Jameson, Teelings, Dublin Liberties or Pearse Lyons where you can learn about the distilling process before taking a tutored sup of the nectar itself. Sláinte!

PLAY "KING OF THE CASTLE"

Malahide Castle is home to an amazing banqueting hall and a mischievous ghost named "Puck". Dublin Castle, dating from 1204AD (and still central to the affairs of the nation) offers a very interesting tour of the State Apartments – and don't miss the adjoining Chester Beatty while there! At Dalkey Castle, costumed actors will take you back in time to Tudor days with Barber Surgery, Archery and Cooking – and don't forget to climb up to the battlements for magnificent views of Dublin's sea and mountains.



TEMPLE BAR

Dublin's Cultural Quarter is located on the south bank of the River Liffey and is home to more than 50 cultural organisations offering you an opportunity to experience contemporary arts in some of the most

spectacular and innovative cultural venues in the city. It's also home to some of the best pubs to visit for daily traditional Irish music sessions.



HOP ON A DUBLIN TOUR

Exploring Dublin is a beautiful thing; that's why the Hop-on/Hop-off tours offered by Dublin Bus, City Sightseeing and Big Bus are such a good idea! Stopping at multiple attractions around the city, visitors are free to hop on and off at their leisure. You can also visit Dublin's coasts and castles on a number of the tours.

6. BROWSE THE CITY OF WORDS

Dublin is a UNESCO City of Literature. The words of Nobel laureates like Yeats, Shaw, Joyce and Beckett echo in its streets. Statues of writers grace parks; their names have been given to bridges, pubs and cafés. Visit the Joyce Museum, The Joyce Tower, Dublin's Writer's Museum, the National Library of Ireland which displays Yeats' Nobel Prize and our brand-new Museum of Literature Ireland.



CITY BY THE SEA

A short ride on the DART light rail is all it takes to access a selection of relaxed seaside villages and beaches. Within half an hour of leaving the city, you can be in a boat on your way to Dalkey Island, eating Michelin-starred food in Malahide, walking the Victorian pier at Dun Laoghaire, or devouring snap-fresh seafood in Howth or Skerries.



OPEN DUBLIN'S DOORS

Dublin has its Georgian streets and squares, the brightly painted, fan-lighted doors which have become an iconic image of the city. Merrion Square is the best known and loved square in Georgian Dublin. Holding Government Buildings and many of the country's National Cultural Institutions, this 250-year-old square surrounds a magnificent park, acting as a green oasis in the centre of the bustling city.



POP INTO A PUB

"In Dublin, you're never more than 20 paces from a pint," remarked JP Dunleavy, author of "The Gingerman". Today you are, typically, also within strolling distance of a range of award-winning gastropubs which provide excellent food and the odd session of trad Irish music. On the traditional front, several pubs around the city, like The Brazen Head, Oliver St John Gogarty's, O'Donoghue's, O'Shea's Merchant Pub and The Cobblestone, put on traditional Irish music sessions and many of them are free. The

Merry Ploughboy Pub, Johnnie Foxes in the Dublin Mountains and the Irish House Party all offer traditional food and shows with live music, song and dance.



MATCH FEVER

When it comes to hurling and Gaelic football, two field sports unique to Ireland, all roads lead to Croke Park. Championship finals at the spectacular 82,300-seater stadium are electrifying and tickets tend to be scarce, but you can relive the glory with the captivating Croke Park Experience in the Gaelic Athletic Association (GAA) Museum. Test your sporting prowess while you're there and finish up with a walk along the 17-storey-high Skyline. Whatever you do, don't look down! If rugby or soccer is more your pitch, the spanking new Aviva Stadium with its iconic curvilinear roof won't disappoint. A behind-the-scenes-tour will serve up some dazzling views and a taste of the match experience.

Tralee Golf Club, Co Kerry, established in 1896, opened Europe's first **Arnold Palmer** designed course in 1984.

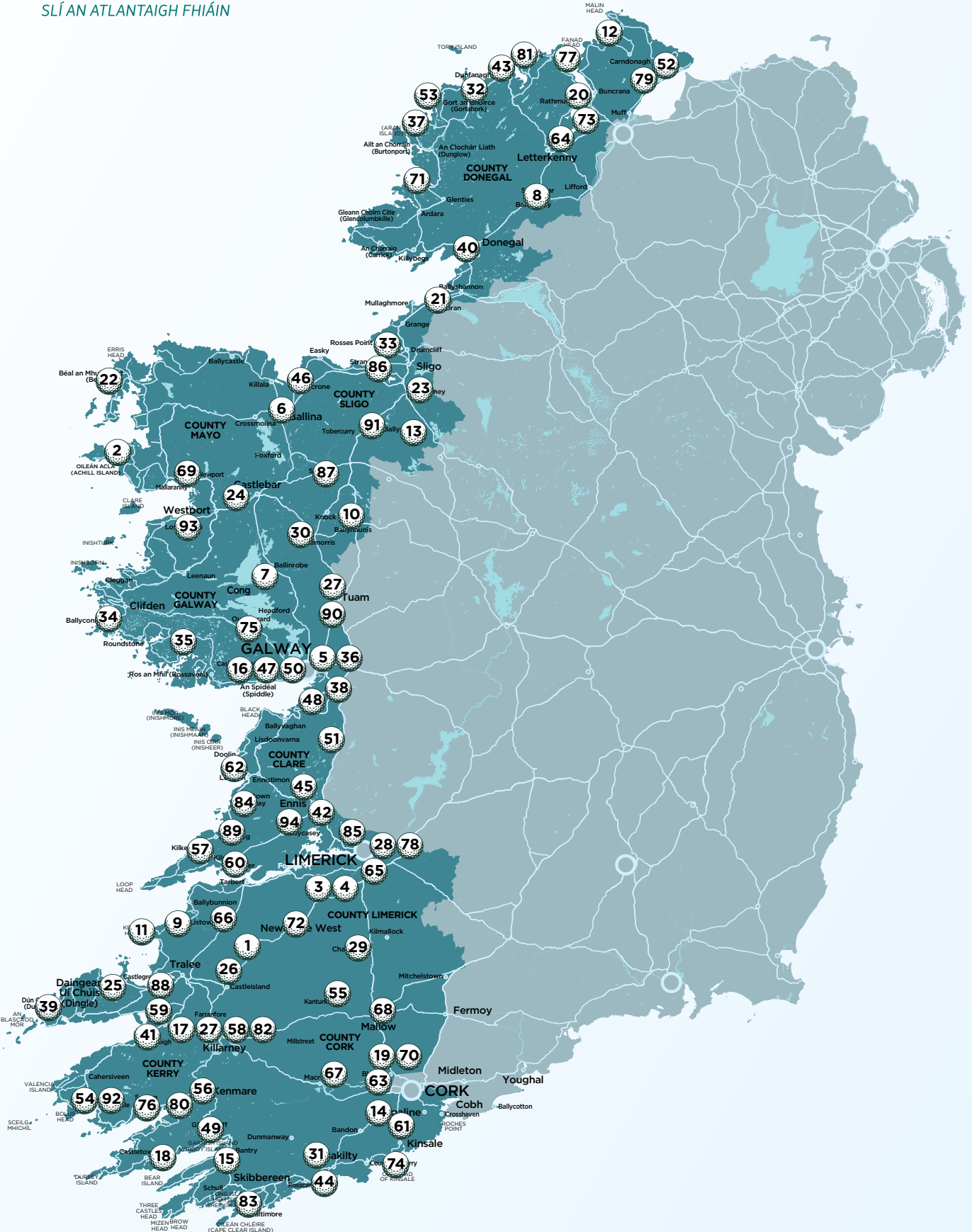
